Constantin Udroiu

Constantin Udroiu was born in 1930 in Bucharest. He studied at the Faculty of Fine Arts of the Romanian capital . Political prisoner from 1954 to 1964, he was a member of the Union of Romanian Plastic Artists. He lived and worked in Rome in 1971. He organized exhibitions in several European countries including: Holland, France, Italy and Romania . He realized many frescoes in Byzantine churches, Romanian and Italian, and in many public and private buildings.

In the laboratory in which Constantin worked every day in solitude as a craftsman monk , there was always a musical background and the framework was created as a score of colors.

The painting of Constantin Udroiu, in fact, is characterized by its solar chromaticism that is both hymn to life and to creation and effect of knowledge of the craft . Rings of yellow corn , the deep blue of the sky and the sea, the blue of the horses. The crimson robes of the saints, gold funds, purple veils. Under the common denominator of the sign are unified color painting sacred and profane, landscapes and figures, places of religions remote Transylvanian and Moldavian and slopes of Abruzzo and Calabria.

The artist uses many techniques : oil on canvas , gouache , watercolor, woodcut and engraving . But even crystals and glass paintings of ancient Venetian tradition .

Udroiu associated to the artistic value respect and peace between peoples through art that invokes various European artists , because Europe's borders extend far beyond the small laboriously Europe we are building . Europe , and Italy especially the South, were places of his painting.

A few years ago , for his holidays , he left the alpine resorts preferring Abruzzo , its mountains and its woods, very relaxing!
